

Dispensary menus that stay current

Create curated print menus, digital displays, and a live inventory TV view from the same PLNTRK product and inventory data.

Build from your catalog, customize what customers see, then print it or put it on a screen.

BUILD A CURATED MENU

Start from active inventory or create a menu from scratch.

- Build a draft directly from the active product catalog.
- Choose the exact product variants you want customers to see.
- Rename menu categories, set sort order, and mark featured items.
- Override display names or descriptions when a menu needs different wording.
- Keep menus in Draft until they are ready to publish.

PRINT + DIGITAL MENUS

Use the same menu data for customer-facing output.

- Download a ready-to-share PDF and use Print Preview for handouts or mailers.
- Open a curated TV display for a lobby or sales floor screen.
- Choose whether to show prices, cannabis details, and out-of-stock products.
- Include text-based header/footer information such as address, phone, and website.
- Clean, text-first layouts keep products and pricing easy to scan.

LIVE INVENTORY TV

No menu setup required - just open the live display.

- Shows all currently available sellable inventory automatically.
- Displays category, product, brand or strain, variant, and price.
- Refreshes automatically so the TV stays aligned with current inventory.
- Auto-fits the full menu to one screen with no scrolling.
- Large categories are distributed across the display to keep the layout readable.

Two easy ways to use a TV

CURATED TV MENU

Best when you want staff to choose products, control sections and order, feature selected items, or maintain a specific customer-facing menu.

LIVE INVENTORY TV

Best when you want a screen that always shows every currently available sellable item without anyone maintaining a separate menu.

Quick start

Open Dispensary Menus

Go to Store Management and open Dispensary Menus.

Choose your workflow

Use Build from catalog, start a New Menu, or open TV Inventory.

Put it in front of customers

Publish, download the PDF, print it, or open a TV display.

LESS MENU MAINTENANCE

Keep product and inventory data in PLNTRK, then reuse it for print, curated TV menus, or the always-current Live Inventory TV.
